# Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995 No 101

## Notice of Final Determination and Amendment of Schedule 2 to Act

The Scientific Committee established under the *Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995* has, in pursuance of Division 3 of Part 2 of that Act, made a final determination to insert the following species of bird in Schedule 2 to that Act (Vulnerable species) and, accordingly, that Schedule is amended as set out in Annexure "A" to this Notice:

### Animals

#### Vertebrates

#### Birds

Meliphagidae

*Melithreptus gularis gularis* (Gould 1837)      Black-chinned Honeyeater  
(eastern subspecies)

The final determination to insert this species in Schedule 2 has been made because the Scientific Committee is of the opinion that the species is likely to become endangered unless the circumstances and factors threatening its survival or evolutionary development cease to operate.
