## **Explanatory note**

Clause 56 of the *Public Authorities* (*Financial Arrangements*) Regulation 2000 prescribes the entities listed in Schedule 4 to that Regulation as being within the definition of *authority* in section 3 (1) of the *Public Authorities* (*Financial Arrangements*) Act 1987.

The object of this Regulation is to amend that Regulation to omit unnecessary references to certain entities from Schedule 4. The entities concerned are already within the definition of *authority* by virtue of being State owned corporations.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act* 1987, including the definition of *authority* in section 3 (1) and section 43 (the general regulation-making power).
