Explanatory note

Clause 56 of the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Regulation 2000* prescribes the entities listed in Schedule 4 to that Regulation as being within the definition of **authority** in section 3 (1) of the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987*.

The object of this Regulation is to amend that Regulation to omit unnecessary references to certain entities from Schedule 4. The entities concerned are already within the definition of **authority** by virtue of being State owned corporations.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987*, including the definition of **authority** in section 3 (1) and section 43 (the general regulation-making power).
