Liquor Amendment Regulation 2001

under the

Liquor Act 1982

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Liquor Act 1982*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Liquor Regulation 1996* to exclude certain premises from the operation of section 23 (3A) of the *Liquor Act 1982*. The effect of the amendment is to exempt certain persons holding a hotelier's licence or certain on-licences from the requirement under the Act to sell or supply liquor to the public. The amendment allows the exempted persons to sell or supply liquor only to a particular class or classes of persons specified in the Regulation.

This Regulation is made under the *Liquor Act 1982*, including sections 23 and 156 (the general regulation-making power).

Clause 83 Exceptions from section 23 (3A) of the Act

Insert in the Table after the matter relating to the “Mona Vale Conference Centre”:

The business carried on under an on-licence relating to premises within a hospital, nursing home, aged care facility or retirement village.

The class of persons resorting to the premises comprising the staff, patients and residents of the hospital, nursing home, aged care facility or retirement village, and their guests.

The business carried on under a hotelier’s licence relating to premises that are used and occupied at The Station Resort, Jindabyne at Lot 13 Dalgety Road, Jindabyne, by Perisher Blue Pty Limited.

The class of persons resorting to the premises comprising the staff and guests of the hotel.
