Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Crimes (Forensic Procedures)* Regulation 2000 to prescribe certain laws of the Commonwealth, the States and Territories as corresponding laws for the purposes of the definition of *corresponding law* in section 95 of the *Crimes (Forensic Procedures)* Act 2000. This definition relates to interstate enforcement of orders for carrying out forensic procedures and the transmission of information on DNA databases.

This Regulation is made under the *Crimes (Forensic Procedures) Act 2000*, including the definition of *corresponding law* in section 95 and section 118 (the general regulation-making power).
