Explanatory note

The entities listed in Schedule 4 to the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Regulation 2000* are prescribed as being within the definition of **authority** in section 3 (1) of the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987*.

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Regulation 2000* to omit certain entities from Schedule 4 to that Regulation as a consequence of the entities being within the definition of **authority** in section 3 (1) of the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987* under another paragraph of the definition.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987*, including the definition of **authority** in section 3 (1) and section 43 (the general regulation-making power).
