Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe a number of hunting organisations for the purpose of section 8 (2) (a) of the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002*. A prescribed hunting organisation can nominate a person to be a member of the Game Council established under that Act.

This Regulation is made under the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002*, including section 8 (2) (a) and section 60 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely, matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Game and Feral Animal Control Regulation 2002*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 11 October 2002.

3 Prescribed hunting organisations

For the purposes of section 8 (2) (a) of the Act, the following hunting organisations are prescribed:

- (a) Australian Deer Association Incorporated,
- (b) Federation of Hunting Clubs Incorporated,
- (c) Australian Hunters International Incorporated,
- (d) Sporting Shooters Association of Australia (New South Wales) Incorporated,
- (e) Hunters and Fishermen Association of New South Wales Artemis Incorporated,
- (f) Game Management Council of New South Wales (Gamecon NSW) Incorporated,
- (g) New South Wales Field & Game Association Incorporated,
- (h) Australian Bowhunters Association Incorporated.
