Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 1999* to ensure that certain offences committed during the 2005 Australia Day period (being 21 January 2005 to 26 January 2005 (inclusive)) attract extra demerit points.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1998*, including sections 15 and 19 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Amendment (Australia Day Demerit Points) Regulation 2005*.

2 Amendment of Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 1999

The *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 1999* is amended by inserting the following at the end of paragraph (b) of the definition of *over a long weekend* in clause 36 (5):

21 January 2005 until 26 January 2005 (inclusive)
