Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prohibit the casino operator from offering or providing indecent or offensive inducements to casino patrons to play gaming machines.

This Regulation is made under the *Casino Control Act 1992*, including sections 76 (Junkets and inducements) and 170 (the general regulation-making power).
