# Police Amendment (Death and Disability) Regulation 2006

## Explanatory note

Amendments made to the *Police Act 1990* by the *Police Amendment (Death and Disability) Act 2005* facilitated the introduction of a new death or incapacity benefits scheme for police officers under a police officers award to be specified.

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the *Crown Employees (Police Officers Death and Disability) Award 2005* as that police officers award.

This Regulation is made under the *Police Act 1990*, including section 219 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 68 of Schedule 4.

### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Police Amendment (Death and Disability) Regulation 2006*.

### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 30 January 2006.

### 3 Amendment of Police Regulation 2000

The *Police Regulation 2000* is amended by inserting after clause 108 the following clause:

#### 109 Prescription of police officers award

For the purposes of the definition of *police officers award* in clause 68 of Schedule 4 to the Act, the *Crown Employees (Police Officers Death and Disability) Award 2005* is prescribed.
