Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Dental Practice Regulation 2004* to provide that hands may be cleaned by using non-water cleansers or antiseptics, whether or not washing facilities involving water and a soap or antiseptic are available.

This Regulation is made under the *Dental Practice Act 2001*, including section 158 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
