# Nurses and Midwives Amendment Regulation 2006

## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Nurses and Midwives Regulation 2003* to provide that hands may be cleaned by using non-water cleansers or antiseptics, whether or not washing facilities involving water and a soap or antiseptic are available.

This Regulation is made under the *Nurses and Midwives Act 1991*, including section 78 (the general regulation-making power).

#### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Nurses and Midwives Amendment Regulation 2006*.

#### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on 31 March 2006.

#### **3 Amendment of Nurses and Midwives Regulation 2003**
