

Physiotherapists Amendment Regulation 2006

under the

Physiotherapists Act 2001

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Physiotherapists Act* 2001.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Physiotherapists Regulation 2002* to provide that hands may be cleaned by using non-water cleansers or antiseptics, whether or not washing facilities involving water and a soap or antiseptic are available.

This Regulation is made under the *Physiotherapists Act 2001*, including section 133 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Physiotherapists Amendment Regulation* 2006.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 31 March 2006.

3 Amendment of Physiotherapists Regulation 2002

The *Physiotherapists Regulation 2002* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.
