Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe a new set of bush fire protection guidelines (known as *Planning for Bush Fire Protection*) that must be conformed with in relation to development of bush fire prone land under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

This Regulation is made under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, including sections 79BA and 157 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Amendment (Planning for Bush Fire Protection) Regulation 2007*.

2 Amendment of Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000

The *Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000* is amended by inserting after clause 271 the following clause:

272 Planning for Bush Fire Protection
