The Administrator, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Institute of Teachers Act 2004*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase from \$80 to \$88 the annual fees payable under the *Institute of Teachers Act 2004* by:

- (a) new scheme teachers who are accredited (other than at professional accomplishment level or professional leadership level), and
- (b) transition scheme teachers who are accredited at professional competence level.

This Regulation is made under the *Institute of Teachers Act 2004*, including sections 25 (Annual fee) and 52 (the general regulation-making power).

Amendment of Institute of Teachers Regulation 2005

The *Institute of Teachers Regulation 2005* is amended by omitting from clause 6 (1) (a) and (b) the matter "\$80" wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter "\$88".
