Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *World Youth Day Act 2006*.

Explanatory note

Section 15A of the *World Youth Day Act 2006* (Minister may direct government agencies to co-operate) provides that the Minister administering the *World Youth Day Act 2006* (currently the Deputy Premier) may direct a prescribed government agency to comply with a request, direction or decision of the World Youth Day Co-ordination Authority made or given under that Act.

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the Council of the City of Sydney as a government agency for the purposes of that section.

This Regulation is made under the *World Youth Day Act 2006*, including sections 15A and 58 (the general regulation-making power).
