Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments made to the *Marine Safety Act 1998* by the *Marine Safety Amendment Act 2008* that deal with the following matters:

- (a) removing provisions relating to surveyor's accreditation and accredited surveyors,
- (b) fees and charges payable in relation to marine safety licences,
- (c) general provisions relating to marine safety licences,
- (d) exemptions from registration requirements for certain vessels,
- (e) offences relating to the operation of vessels,

Explanatory note

- (f) qualifying certain exemptions from holding a boat driving licence,
- (g) enabling the making of regulations in relation to marine safety equipment and facilities and builders plates to be fixed to vessels.
