Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Management of Waters and Waterside Lands Regulations—N.S.W.* to remove certain provisions and update a reference as a consequence of the repeal of the *Boating (Safety Equipment) Regulation—N.S.W.*, the *Navigation (Collision) Regulations 1983* and the *Water Traffic Regulations—N.S.W.*.

This Regulation is made under the *Maritime Services Act 1935*, including sections 30D and 38 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Management of Waters and Waterside Lands Amendment Regulation 2009*.
