Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to update a reference to the office-holders in the Australian Security Intelligence Organisation (*ASIO*) to whom the chief executive officer of ASIO may delegate functions under the *Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Act 1998*.

This Regulation is made under the *Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Act 1998*, including sections 16 (Delegations) and 19 (the general regulation-making power).
