Explanatory note

The *Shop Trading Act 2008* provides that the Director-General may, on application, exempt a shop from trading restrictions under that Act.

The object of this Regulation is to provide that no application fee is required to accompany an application for such an exemption.

This Regulation is made under the *Shop Trading Act 2008*, including sections 11 and 22 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters of a machinery nature.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Shop Trading Regulation 2009*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

In this Regulation, *the Act* means the *Shop Trading Act 2008*.

4 No fee for applications for exemptions from trading restrictions

For the purposes of section 11 of the Act, no application fee is required to accompany an application for exemption.
