Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Workers Compensation Regulation 2003* to enable the WorkCover Authority to delegate functions relating to scheme agents to a person who is a part-time member of the Board of Directors of the Authority.

This Regulation is made under the *Workplace Injury Management and Workers Compensation Act 1998*, including sections 21 (3) and 248 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Workers Compensation Amendment (Delegation) Regulation 2009*.

3 Amendment of Workers Compensation Regulation 2003

Clause 197A

Insert after clause 197:

197A Delegation of Authority's functions: sec 21 of 1998 Act

The class of persons consisting of part-time members of the Board of Directors is prescribed for the purposes of the definition of *authorised person* in section 21 (3) of the 1998 Act, but only in respect of the delegation of any functions of the Authority relating to scheme agents (including the appointment of scheme agents).
