Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Surveying Regulation 2006 (the Principal Regulation)* to increase certain fees and deposits payable under the *Surveying Act 2002*. The Principal Regulation will no longer provide for a fee for the supply of an evidentiary certificate.

This Regulation is made under the *Surveying Act 2002*, including section 36 (the general regulation-making power) and, in particular, section 36 (2) (j).

1 Name of Regulation
