## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Police Regulation 2008* to provide that the regulations under the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 2002* apply to the selection of administrative officers and temporary employees employed under the *Police Act 1990*.

This Regulation is made under the *Police Act 1990*, including section 219 (the general regulation-making power).

### 1 Name of Regulation

### 2 Amendment of Police Regulation 2008

Insert after clause 69 (1) (e):

(f) selection procedures.

#### (3) Clause 69 (2A)

Insert after clause 69 (2):

(2A) For the purposes of applying those regulations, the reference in clause 9 (2) (b) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management (General) Regulation 1996* to the branch of the Department in which the vacant position exists is to be read as a reference to the command in which the vacant position exists.
