Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend Appendix C (Persons authorised to possess and use substances) to the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* so as to enable certain authorised persons to possess and use methoxyflurane if required for use in connection with the carrying out of first aid at a mine.

This Regulation is made under the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966*, including paragraph (d) of the definition of **Supply by wholesale** in section 4 (1) and sections 10 (4) (d) and 45C (the general regulation-making power).
