Explanatory note

The *Water Industry Competition (General) Regulation 2008* exempts water or sewerage infrastructure that was being constructed or operated before that Regulation commenced, from the requirement for a licence under the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006*. The exemption operates until 8 August 2009. The object of this Regulation is to extend the operation of the exemption until 8 August 2010.

This Regulation is made under the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006*, including section 101 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 1 of Schedule 4 (the power to make regulations of a savings or transitional nature).
