## **Explanatory note**

The object of these Rules is to amend rule 6.2 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* so as to provide that originating process for proceedings in the Land and Environment Court is valid for service for 6 months after the date on which it is filed, as is the case for proceedings in the Supreme Court, the Dust Diseases Tribunal and the Local Court.
