Electricity Supply (General) Amendment Regulation 2009

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Electricity Supply Act 1995*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Electricity Supply (General) Regulation 2001* so as:

- (a) to provide that all customers who are transferred to a retailer of last resort under last resort supply arrangements may be required to pay a last resort supply fee (not exceeding \$50) to that retailer (currently customers under standard form customer supply contracts are exempted from the fee), and
- (b) to extend the scheme for the determination of electricity tariffs by the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal to 30 June 2013, and
- (c) to extend the operation of the Electricity Tariff Equalisation Fund to 30 June 2011.

This Regulation is made under the *Electricity Supply Act 1995*, including sections 43EJ, 43ES and 191 (the general regulation-making power).
