The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the 2009 *Animal Welfare Code of Practice—Breeding of Dogs and Cats* (published by the Department of Industry and Investment) as the relevant code of practice for animal breeding establishments.

This Regulation is made under the *Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979*, including section 35 (the general regulation-making power).
