Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Regulation 2006* to:

- (a) prescribe certain offences under the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Act 2004* that relate to the sale of electrical articles as penalty notice offences, and
- (b) increase the penalty notice amount for the sale of an electrical article that is not marked in accordance with that Regulation from \$200 to \$500.

This Regulation is made under the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Act 2004*, including section 47 and section 55 (the general regulation-making power).
