Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 1 to the *Annual Reports (Departments) Regulation 2005* by replacing a reference to the ethnic affairs priority statement with a reference to the multicultural policies and services program. Schedule 1 of that Regulation prescribes certain matters and particulars that must be included in the annual report prepared by a Department.

This Regulation is made under the *Annual Reports (Departments) Act 1985*, including section 11 and section 20 (the general regulation-making power).
