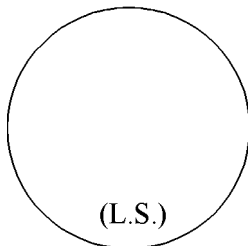

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Children Legislation Amendment (Wood Inquiry Recommendations) Act 2009* that authorise certain agencies to exchange information concerning the safety, welfare or well-being of children and young persons and to co-ordinate the services those agencies provide.
