Explanatory note

Sections 41 and 42 of the *Health Services Act 1997* provide for the constitution of new statutory health corporations by the insertion of the name of the proposed corporation in Schedule 2 to that Act. A statutory health corporation is governed by either a chief executive or a board as specified in Schedule 2.

The object of this Order is to amend Schedule 2 to the Act to constitute the Agency for Clinical Innovation as a statutory health corporation that is to be governed by a board.

This Order is made under section 42 of the *Health Services Act 1997*.
