Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 1 to the *Public Health Act 1991* to include rotavirus in the list of Category 3 medical conditions, with the effect that, pursuant to section 16 of that Act, a testing laboratory will be required to notify any detected instance of rotavirus to the Director-General of the Department of Health.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Health Act 1991*, including sections 80 and 82 (the general regulation-making power).
