Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Travel Agents Regulation 2006* to prescribe the new national standard training Unit of Competency SITTSL013A (Construct normal international airfares) as an alternate qualification for a person in charge of the day-to-day conduct of a business of a travel agent that involves the sale of tickets, or the arrangement of rights of passage, for international travel or international travel and accommodation.

This Regulation is made under the *Travel Agents Act 1986*, including sections 36 and 57 (the general regulation-making power).
