Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 1 (Court fees) to the *Civil Procedure Regulation 2005* to clarify that one fee of \$50 is payable whether one or more sealed or certified copies of a judgment or order, or the written opinion or reasons for the opinion of any judicial or other officer of the court, are supplied.

This Regulation is made under the *Civil Procedure Act 2005*, including section 18.
