The object of this Regulation is to increase the penalty notice amount for failing to comply with a sign or notice that regulates the conduct of persons on or in areas controlled by NSW Maritime from \$60 to \$250.

This Regulation is made under the *Maritime Services Act 1935*, including sections 30D and 38 (the general regulation-making power).
