Explanatory note

Currently, the *Marine Safety (General) Regulation 2009* adopts, with some modifications, the *International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (the International Regulations)*. One such modification extends Rule 9 of the International Regulations, which relates to the conduct of vessels in narrow channels or fairways, to all channels and fairways, regardless of width.

The object of this Regulation is to remove that modification.

This Regulation is made under the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, including sections 10 (2) and 137 (the general regulation-making power).
