Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Law Enforcement (Controlled Operations) Act 1997* to prescribe the *Crimes (Controlled Operations) Act 2008* of the Australian Capital Territory as a corresponding law, in order to recognise the Australian Capital Territory as a participating jurisdiction for the purposes of cross-border controlled operations.

This Regulation is made under the *Law Enforcement (Controlled Operations) Act 1997*, including sections 4 and 31 (the general regulation-making power).
