Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to increase the fees payable in relation to civil proceedings generally and other fees that are payable to the Sheriff, and
- (b) to provide that the fees for the filing of notices of cross-appeal in the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court are the same as the fees for the filing of notices of appeal in that Court

This Regulation is made under the Civil Procedure Act 2005, including section 18 (Fees).
