

Local Government (General) Amendment (Minimum Rates) Regulation 2010

Explanatory note

Under section 548 of the *Local Government Act 1993*, a council may specify a minimum amount for ordinary rates that must not exceed the minimum amount prescribed by the regulations. The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Local Government (General) Regulation 2005* to increase the minimum amount prescribed from \$419 to \$430.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including sections 548 (3) (a) and 748 (the general regulation making power).
