Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995

The Scientific Committee established under the *Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995* has made final determinations to insert the species referred to in paragraphs (a)–(e) as vulnerable species under that Act and, accordingly, Schedule 2 to that Act is amended as follows:
