Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to remake, with minor amendments, the provisions of the *Gambling (Two-up) Regulation 2005*, which is repealed on 1 September 2010 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

This Regulation makes provision with respect to the following:

- (a) the commemorative days on which two-up may be played,
- (b) formal matters.

This Regulation is made under the *Gambling (Two-up) Act 1998*, including sections 4A (1) and 31 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely matters of a machinery nature and matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Gambling (Two-up) Regulation 2010*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 September 2010 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

Note. This Regulation replaces the *Gambling (Two-up) Regulation 2005* which is repealed on 1 September 2010 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

3 Definition

(1) In this Regulation:

the Act means the *Gambling (Two-up) Act 1998*.

(2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 Commemorative days

For the purposes of section 4A (1) of the Act, the following days or parts of a day are prescribed as commemorative days:

- (a) 15 August (in any year),
- (b) 11 November (in any year, but only that part of that day that is after 12 noon).
