Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include the National Measurement Institute in the list of employers in Schedule 3 to the *Superannuation Act 1916*. This is to reflect agreement between the Commonwealth and State governments that will see the National Measurement Institute replace the relevant State authorities responsible for trade measurement. Employees of the National Measurement Institute who were previously employed in the Department of Services, Technology and Administration immediately before 1 July 2010, in a function relating to trade measurement, are to retain membership of the State Superannuation Fund.
