Food Amendment (Beef Labelling) Regulation 2010

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Food Act 2003*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Food Regulation 2010* to prescribe the AUS-MEAT Domestic Retail Beef Register as the AUS-MEAT manual for the purposes of section 23B (5) of the *Food Act 2003*. This will enable a person carrying on a food business that involves the advertising, packaging or labelling of beef for sale to use the language used in that Register for the purposes of describing the type, quality, classification, category, cut or grade of the beef.

This Regulation is made under the *Food Act 2003*, including the definition of *AUS-MEAT manual* in section 23B (5) and section 139 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Food Amendment (Beef Labelling) Regulation 2010*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 31 August 2010 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
