Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make an amendment to the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2008* that is consequential on the commencement of amendments to the *Road Rules 2008* concerning the use of child restraints in motor vehicles.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1998*, including sections 15 and 19 (the general regulation-making power).
