Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make an amendment to the *Road Transport (General) Regulation 2005* that is consequential on the commencement of amendments to the *Road Rules 2008* concerning the use of child restraints in motor vehicles.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (General) Act 2005*, including sections 10 (the general regulation-making power) and 183.
