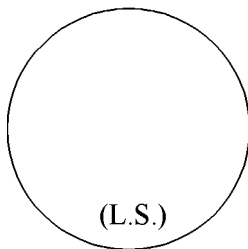

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Crimes Amendment (Child Pornography and Abuse Material) Act 2010* that did not commence on the date of assent to that Act. The provisions that commenced on the date of assent relate to the extension of protections afforded to complainants in sexual offence cases.
