1 Name of Rules

3 Amendment of Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005

Rule 10.1 Service of filed document

Insert at the end of rule 10.1:

- (3) Despite subrule (2), a defence that is filed in proceedings in the Local Court by means of the ECM system (within the meaning of Part 3) must be served on the other parties by the party that filed the defence rather than by an officer of the Local Court.
