Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe certain offences under the *Food Act 2003* relating to the appointment and notification of appointment of food safety supervisors and the inspection of food safety supervisor certificates as offences for which a penalty notice may be issued. The operation of those offences is delayed until 1 October 2011 by clause 23 of Schedule 2 to that Act.

This Regulation is made under the *Food Act 2003*, including sections 120 and 139 (the general regulation-making power).
