Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to give effect to a revised Assessment Methodology for the purposes of the *Native Vegetation Regulation 2005*. The Assessment Methodology is a methodology adopted by that Regulation for assessing and determining whether a proposed clearing improves or maintains environmental outcomes in relation to an application for development consent for development involving broadscale clearing, or for approval of a property vegetation plan that proposes broadscale clearing.

This Regulation is made under the *Native Vegetation Act 2003*, including section 51 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
